Author Visit Program Offerings:

Basic Author Reading Visit

Visit Format: Author will read her book for your group. Simultaneous Powerpoint presentation of book illustrations recommended for use in large group presentations. Reading takes approximately 10 minutes. Optional Q & A may follow. May be combined with book signing and/or sale.

Maximum program time: 30 minutes

Age Recommendation: Pre-K through 3

Group Size: Flexible

Site requirements: InFocus projector or opaque overhead projector and screen recommended for groups of over 30 or large venues. Electrical outlets, microphone/sound system also required for auditorium-style venue.

Book Signing/Sale

Visit Format: Author will sign and/or sell books at your event. Author may also have other book-related merchandise available to sell as well. Photos welcome.

Maximum event time: 5 hours.

Age Recommendation: N/A

Group Size: N/A

Site requirements: Large table and chair. Coverage for short breaks for events spanning more than 1 hour.

Large or Small Group Author Visit and Presentation

Visit Format: Author will give a dynamic, age-appropriate Powerpoint presentation explaining how she became an artist and how her book was created, followed by Q & A. Reading of book is optional.

Maximum program time: 45 minutes

Age Recommendation: Grades 1 through 4

Group Size: Maximum- 250

Site requirements: InFocus projector or opaque overhead projector and screen, electrical outlets, table and chair, easel. Microphone/sound system required for auditorium-style venue and most large group programs.

Author Visit and Activity (small groups only)

Visit Format: Author will read her book or give a brief presentation explaining how she became an artist and how her book was created. Presentation is followed by a related hands-on art activity or creative writing activity. Activity is tailored to be grade-level appropriate; one grade level per presentation group preferred.

Program time: 30 to 90 minutes, depending on choice of activity and grade level

Age Recommendation: Grades K through 4

Group Size: 20 and under

Site requirements: (Varies by presentation) Tables and chairs or desks for students required. Materials for activities will be provided by the author and are included in the presentation fee. InFocus projector or opaque overhead projector and screen and electrical outlets may be needed as well.

Author Visit Presentation: Make Your Dreams Happen- Careers in Art and Self-Publishing

Visit Format: Author will give a dynamic, age-appropriate Powerpoint presentation explaining how she became an artist and how her book was created and self-published. Careers in art and how young artists can get started will be hi-lighted, followed by Q & A. Hands-on art activity, creative writing exercise, or student portfolio critique option available for small groups only.

Program time: 60 to 90 minutes.

Age Recommendation: Grades 5 through 12

Group Size: Large group maximum- 100

Small group maximum- 20

Site requirements: InFocus projector or opaque overhead projector and screen, electrical outlets, table and chair. Microphone/sound system required for auditorium-style venue and most large group programs. Table space or desks for students if including hands-on activities. Materials for activities will be provided by the author and are included in the presentation fee unless otherwise arranged.

Workshop: Exploring Illustration in Children's Picture Books

Visit Format: This workshop introduces the art elements, styles, and materials used by illustrators as well as major developments in the tradition of children's picture book illustration. The author/illustrator will discuss her experiences writing, creating, self-publishing and marketing a children's picture book. Special session for educators include tips on choosing and using picture books for all ages of students across the curriculum, as well as illustration project outlines, lesson plan guidelines and assessment models for practical classroom use. Presentation style includes Powerpoint supported lecture, Q & A/ discussion and hands-on activities such as *Exploring Illustration Materials* and *Bring a Book to Life: Book Dummy Construction*. Full-color printed companion presentation booklet provided to all participants.

Program time: 60 minutes to full-day workshops, depending on content.

Program Focus Choices: Full Presentation, Children's Book Illustration Traditions and Techniques, Children's Book Illustration for the Classroom Teacher, Real-Life Experience: Creating and Self-Publishing a Children's Picture Book

Age Recommendation: Adults / Educators

Group Size: Flexible

Site requirements: InFocus projector or opaque overhead projector and screen, electrical outlets, table, table space or desks for participants if including hands-on activities. Materials for activities will be provided by the author and are included in the presentation fee unless otherwise arranged.
